





International students: admission requirements (extract)


- Bachelor: Recognised highschool diploma / baccalaureate similar to higher education entrance qualification in FL / CH / AT (Matura, Abitur)
- Admission interview*
- Letter of motivation, Portfolio (Architecture)*
- Language Skills English (B2) and/or German (C1)*
- Master: Relevant Bachelor's degree programme or equivalent university degree programme of at least 180 ECTS or comparable
- Master: Outstanding academic performance
- Master: Proof of scientific competence (Module, Thesis etc.)
- Master: Type and duration of any relevant professional activity



International students: Visa and residence permit

Students from most third countries outside the EU/EEA/Switzerland require a visa for entry to Liechtenstein.



- As part of the application process, the University of Liechtenstein provides you with all necessary information and supports students during the visa process. Do NOT start the visa process on your own.
- The University of Liechtenstein provides a bank guarantee, after a deposit amounting to CHF 3,000 is paid by the student to the University of Liechtenstein.
- This amount is retained as a security deposit and will be refunded at the finish of studies.
- International students need to apply for a temporary short-term residence permit in Liechtenstein.
- If the study requirements, such as the required language certificate, are not met, admission to the programme is revoked and the residence permit is withdrawn.
