

## **Fees Regulations University of Liechtenstein**

Enacted by the University Council by virtue of Article 29 of the *Gesetz vom 25. November 2004 über die Universität Liechtenstein*

Vaduz, 27 November 2017

#### **Art. 1**

##### ***Administration fee for admission applications – education***

Students who have never been enrolled in a Bachelor's, Master's or Doctoral degree programme at the University of Liechtenstein and who apply for admission to one of these programmes are required to pay an administration fee of CHF 100,-.

#### **Art. 2**

##### ***Tuition fees education***

- 1) For Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral degree programmes the following tuition fees apply as of winter semester 2018/2019 for students per semester (CHF 10,- per semester of these fees are used for services of the students):
  - a) Citizens of EU/EEA countries and Switzerland as well as other citizens with a permanent permit to stay or residence permit for Liechtenstein or with a university entrance certificate received in an EU/EEA country or Switzerland: CHF 950,-.
  - b) Citizens from countries other than EU/EEA countries and Switzerland who do not fulfil any of the conditions mentioned above: CHF 1.250,-.
- 2) Students on leave of absence are required to pay a fee of CHF 100,- per semester.
- 3) Visiting students studying at the University of Liechtenstein pursuant to mobility programmes and/or partnership contracts are not required to pay tuition fees.
- 4) Occasional students are required to pay a fee in accordance with the number of modules taken, with the minimum fee being CHF 500,-. The actual fee per module is determined by the President's Board in an implementing regulation of the fees regulations, which is to be brought to the attention of the University Council.

#### **Art. 3**

##### ***Tuition fees continuing education***

The President's Board is authorized to determine the tuition fees for the higher education study programmes in line with customary fees. The tuition fees applying to continuing education are to be brought to the attention of the University Council and to be announced on the homepage of the University of Liechtenstein.

#### **Art. 4**

##### ***Examination fees***

Fees for examinations are included in the tuition fees. Fees for resit examinations are determined by the President's Board in an implementing regulation of the fees regulations.

#### **Art. 5**

##### ***Fees for special services of the University***

For further services of the University of Liechtenstein, in particular administration, rental and decision fees, the University Council delegates the determination of the amount and levying of fees to the President's Board of the University of Liechtenstein, which enacts a corresponding implementing regulation of the fees regulations and brings it to the attention of the University Council.

**Art. 6**

***Entry into force and transitional regulation***

- 1) The fees regulations enter into force on 1 December 2017.
  
- 2) Up to and including summer semester 2018 tuition fees of CHF 850,- per semester are to be paid for Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral degree programmes in accordance with the fees regulations of 10 June 2013.
