

Understanding your placement result

1) Example 1: Overall result and Use of English score are higher than 74 points:

|--|------------|-----|
| Score | Time taken | CEF |
| 76 | 00:43 | B2 |

→ recommendation: **Overall result is higher than 74 points**

| Use of English: | | |
|-----------------|------------|----------------|
| Score | Time taken | Use of English |
| 65 | 00:19 | B2 |

→ recommendation: **But "Use of English" score is a low B2 level.**

→ recommendation: **Activation in English II**
