Ruhr area: the aesthetics of an agglomeration

Together we want to explore the variety of the Ruhr area in form of field research and self-awareness. We will set a variety of topics that we are going to discover: urban quality of life, free mobility, agriculture and self-sufficiency, urban culture and heritage, diversity etc.
