The doctoral degree programme in architecture and planning is designed to prepare students to thrive in a local as well as international academic environment. It emphasizes collaboration, publication, science communication, and teaching experience.

as well as the possibility to conduct a PhD by design.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of a consecutive master's degree of an university or an equivalent other university degree
- Consecutive studies of at least 270 ECTS; at least 60 ECTS in a master's degree programme in architecture and planning
- Excellent English (level C1 certificate)
- Exposé (research proposal)
- Commitment for supervision from a professor of the University of Liechtenstein
