


## Link SWITCH edu-ID with the organisational identity (AAI) of the University of Liechtenstein

If you are a member of the University of Liechtenstein and already have a SWITCH edu-ID, you can link it to the organisational identity (AAI) of the University of Liechtenstein as follows. You can also link several organisational identities (AAI) if you are a member of the university with multiple functions, e.g:

- An employee of the University of Liechtenstein AND a student at the same or another university.
- Employee at several universities in Switzerland and Liechtenstein, etc.
  - 1. Log in to https://eduid.ch with your existing SWITCH edu-ID.




2. Scroll down to the "Linked identities" section and click on the + sign next to "Add organisation identity"





3. Select "University of Liechtenstein" from the drop-down list and click on "Continue".



4. Log in with the login data of the University of Liechtenstein (such as Moodle or my.uni.li).






## 5. Data added to your SWITCH edu-ID will now be displayed.

(This data will overwrite existing values in your SWITCH edu-ID, as the quality from SWITCHaai is usually higher).

Click on "Ask again if..." and "Accept".



6. Click on "Continue" to link the two accounts.



7. Your organisation identity(ies) should now be displayed under the linked identities.





In this way, further organisational identities can be added. You are automatically registered with SLSP with all the specified identities and benefit from the respective privileges.

## **GLOSSARY:**

**SLSP:** Swiss Library Service Platform

**SWITCH:** SWITCH is a trustworthy non-profit organisation founded by the Confederation and the university cantons.

**SWITCH edu-ID:** One identity for all services in the Swiss university environment, regardless of the organisation, valid for life

**SWITCHaai:** «Authentication and Authorization Infrastructure is an authentication procedure administered by the SWITCH foundation and used by all universities and universities of applied sciences in Switzerland, offering access to various services.
