

Online access to licensed e-resources

To access databases, e-books and other electronic resources licensed through the library, members of the University of Liechtenstein may choose from two options.

On campus

- **PC workstations:** One is located in the library's reading room.
- **UNI_INT:** This WiFi is available to employees and students.
Access by private devices is granted after connecting and authenticating with the username "firstname.lastname@uni.li" and personal password. To use UNI_INT, a **certificate** must be installed on Windows laptops or trusted on devices with other operating systems. The certificate for Windows is available by <https://uni.li/cert>. You need Internet access to install it.
- **EDUROAM:** This WiFi is available to employees and students even at other universities. Please access the help page for more information <https://www.uni.li/eduroam>.

Remote Access Citrix

By using CITRIX, licensed electronic resources can be accessed from home or via a external WiFi.

To do so, the following IT setup must be performed and login credentials must be used:

- Install **Citrix Workspace App** on personal PC/notebook.
- Download **Microsoft Authenticator** on mobile phone.
- **Username:** "firstname.lastname@uni.li" (eg. hanna.example@uni.li; no private email account!)
- **Password:** your uni.li password (same as for Moodle or my.uni.li)

Please note that you also use multi-factor authentication for this service. You will be automatically asked to do so after logging in. Then click on the **Google Chrome Browser App** provided by Citrix.

For "first level aid" on the Citrix application, library staff will be happy to assist you during open hours (library@uni.li).
